- A What measuring tool can we rely on to give us instruction, and an accurate assessment of the health of our worship?

At times we may think that worshiping with other believers isn't worth the bother. Why not just worship God on our own at home? Note carefully the description of God's people in Hebrews 10:25.

How well does this reflect your own involvement with other believers in Christ?

Colossians 3:16 says, "Let the word of Christ dwell (take up permanent residence) in you richly..." How would you summarize the way God's Word should influence our singing and worship services at Gospel Grace Church?

How does the Word of God function in providing the fuel for your worship?

How does Christ's words in Matthew 4:4, and the testimony of Job in Job 23:12 resonate with your heart when you think about the manner in which you read, memorize and meditate on God's Word?
